America's Boating Course, or ABC-3, is the 8-hour introduction to boating for starting or continuing one's recreational boating education. Virginia law requires all motorized watercraft operators pass a boater safety course and carry a boater education card. The course has a proctored final exam and provides a state and nationally recognized safe boating certificate, approved by NASBLA. The Washington Sailing Marina near Ronald Reagan National Airport has plenty of outdoor seating for the exam and offers a great opportunity to look at different types of boats to apply newly acquired knowledge.

Topics include:

- Types of boats and their uses
- Boating laws, both federal and state, Knots and Lines
- Safety equipment, both required and recommended
- Buoys and Aids to Navigation, Communications
- Rules of the Road, Lights and Sound Signals, Anchoring
- Charts and Electronic Navigation, Anchoring
- Proper Maritime Communications Procedures
- Trailering, Handling Emergencies, Water Sports Safety
